

EMERGENCY RESOLUTION NO. 11-2022

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE LOWEST AND/OR BEST BID SUBMITTED FOR THE STATE ROUTE 63 AND INTERSTATE 75 INTERCHANGE MOWING AND LANDSCAPING CONTRACT AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF MONROE AND OLYMPIC LAWNS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, after advertising and bidding according to law, Council desires to accept the lowest and/or best bid for the State Route 63 and Interstate 75 Interchange Mowing and Landscaping Contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: The bid submitted by Olympic Lawns is hereby declared to be the lowest and/or best bid for the State Route 63 and Interstate 73 Interchange Mowing and Landscaping Contract.

SECTION 2: Council hereby accepts the bid referenced herein and authorizes the City Manager to enter into an agreement by and between the City of Monroe and Olympic Lawns pursuant to the terms and conditions contained in the bid documents submitted on February 8, 2022.

SECTION 3: This measure is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and further for the reason that Council desires to award this bid at the earliest possible date and prior to the need for the services. Therefore, this measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.
