INTRODUCTION

1.1 PROJECT BACKGROUND

This project began following the Monroe Parks and Recreation Master Plan, which was completed in April 2016. During the public input of that project, Monroe residents showed strong support for improvements to existing parks, including a desire for access to Baker Park which had been designated for athletic fields years earlier. The City of Monroe engaged the services of Brandstetter Carroll Inc. to develop a master plan for the park to ensure it meets the needs of the community.

1.2 SCOPE OF THE PLAN

The master planning process had three phases: site analysis, public input, and recommendations. The details of each phase are described below.

1.2.1 Site Analysis

The site analysis phase of this master plan process provided a summary of existing conditions at the site and opportunities for the future. The property was designated to be developed as a sports complex, but the presence of flood prone areas on most of the site made that unfeasible. The site analysis reviewed the following items to evaluate site potential and to determine limitations of the property.

- Historical Use
- Topographic Features
- Site Access
- Surrounding Land Use
- Soils
- Floodplain Locations
- Visual Impact of Development

These items plus information resulting from site visits was used to prepare a map outlining Opportunities and Constraints, which separated the park into development areas.

1.2.2 Public Input

This public input consisted of the following elements:

- Public Meeting
- Web-Based and Handout Survey
- Steering Committee

The public engagement process was essential to identify the needs and preferences of Monroe residents and potential park users, and the findings were integral to the recommendations of this master plan.

1.2.3 Master Plan and Recommendations

The results of the site analysis and the public input were utilized to develop alternative concepts, followed by a preliminary master plan that was presented to the Steering Committee, the Park Board, and finally the City Council. The master plan shows the proposed features and their orientation throughout the site. The recommendations also included detailed descriptions of the proposed features and a cost estimate for the improvements presented in the master plan.

1.2.4 Master Plan Report

A draft of the Baker Park Master Plan was delivered to the City of Monroe in May 2018. The recommendations were presented to City Council on May 8, 2018, and the final Master Plan report was delivered to the city in June.

SITE ANALYSIS

2.1 INTRODUCTION

The site analysis phase of this master plan process provides a summary of existing conditions at the site and the opportunities for future development.

2.2 SITE CHARACTERISTICS

The Baker Park property was donated to the City of Monroe by Baker-Monroe Properties to be used for recreational purposes, specifically sports fields. However, most of the property is located in flood prone areas (See Subsection 2.2.6) making it unsuitable for development of structures, including those needed to support athletic fields. If developed, any fields would frequently flood making them unusable for the intended uses during that time. The property fortunately has potential for other recreational uses.

2.2.1 Historical Use

Prior to donation to the city, the land was used primarily for agricultural purposes.

2.2.2 Topographic Features

Baker Park is characterized by large flat fields bordered by wooded areas along the eastern edge and running through the middle part of the site along a drainage ditch (east/west) and Millers Creek (north/south). All but a small portion of the site (approximately 7.5 acres in the north portion) is located within the 100-year floodplain of Millers Creek. The more restrictive floodway (within the 100-year floodplain) covers over half of the site (approximately 26.5 acres). The northeastern edge of the property is bounded by a railroad operated by Genesee & Wyoming. The southeastern portion of the park contains wetland areas and is heavily wooded, while the majority of the park is covered by former farmland with minimal vegetation.

2.2.3 Site Access

Baker Park currently has no public access and no paved roads entering the property. Access to the property is currently located near the northern edge of the site where a culvert provides a crossing over the drainage ditch running along the edge of Cincinnati-Dayton Road. The southwestern portion of the site can be accessed along Cincinnati-Dayton Road. Millers Creek runs through the site, there is currently no way to cross it within the park.

2.2.4 Surrounding Land Use

The site is bordered to the west by Cincinnati-Dayton Road, and the land on the other side of the road is agricultural except at the northern end where the land is commercial, industrial, or exempt. A railroad (Genesee & Wyoming) runs along the northeastern edge of the site, and the land on the other side of the tracks is industrial. The land to the south of the property is mostly agricultural with some industrial to the southeast. The closest residential area is to the southwest of the park along Todhunter Road, about a quarter of a mile from the edge of the property. A second residential area is located to the east of the property, but most of these residents would need to travel at least a mile to enter the site despite their close proximity.

2.2.5 Soils




Figure 2.3: Effective Floodplain

Figure 2.3 shows the soils present at Baker Park. According to the Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) Soil Survey, all of the soils on the site are prime farmland or prime farmland if drained. A majority of the site is characterized by Patton silty clay loam (Pa) which is prime farmland if drained. This soil, according to NRCS is poorly drained and prone to ponding. A sizable area in the middle of the site is Thackery silt loam (ThA) which is moderately well drained prime farmland. A small portion at the northeast is Russell-Miamian silt loams (RvB), and another small portion along the Northwestern edge is Ross loam (Rn). Both of these soils are well-drained prime farmland. These soils explain why the property was previously used for agriculture.

2.2.6 Floodplain Locations

The Effective FIRM flood map (2010) indicates that nearly the entire site is within the 100-year floodplain (Figure 2.3), and much of the property is located within the floodway. Location within the floodway would prevent development of structures on those portions of the site. The flood elevation on the Baker Park site is between 655 and 656 feet.

The Preliminary FIRM flood map (2014) indicates a slightly increased percentage of the site is located in flood prone areas. The preliminary map also identifies a 500-year floodplain for the park. The preliminary map shows the flood elevation to one decimal, so the flood elevation ranges only from 655.7 to 656.0 feet.

A survey will be required to determine the exact location of the floodplain, and modeling is required to determine the floodway, which is located within the 100-year floodplain. The flood elevation in the Effective FIRM map represents the legal boundary of the floodplain and must be used for design at this time. However, the Preliminary FIRM will likely become effective eventually and will adjust the location of the development restrictions.

2.2.7 Visual Impact of Development

Currently, the site is an undeveloped property seen only from N. Main Street/Cincinnati-Dayton Road. The site has few immediate neighbors other than some adjacent farms and industrial areas. Due to the passive nature of the proposed park, the future developments will likely have minimal visual impact on the neighboring properties or over as seen from the road.

2.3 OPPORTUNITIES AND CONSTRAINTS

The information in Section 2.2 plus information resulting from a site visit was used to prepare a map outlining Opportunities and Constraints. This map (Figure 2.5) separated the park into seven areas based on existing site characteristics:

- Site Entry
- North Open Field
- Vegetative Screening
- Wooded Wetland
- South Open Field
- Stream Corridors

- West Open Field

These areas identify portions of the park with different characteristics and areas of transition. The map describes the character of each of these areas, such as tree species, aesthetic value, and potential features the area would support. Most of the future development will be located within the open field areas (see below left). The Millers Creek corridor functions as a barrier between the main portion of the site and the West Open Field. The vegetation along this corridor is dense and, in many places, impassable (see below center). A ditch currently running through the center of the site represents a barrier between the North Open Field and the South Open Field. Many native species of healthy trees were observed in the Wooded Wetland (below right), but much of the area is characterized by hydric soils.





Figure 2.4: Preliminary Floodplain





PUBLIC INPUT

3.1 INTRODUCTION

This chapter summarizes the public input gathered throughout the planning process, including the following elements:

1. Public Meeting
2. Web-Based and Handout Survey
3. Steering Committee

The public engagement process is essential to identify the needs and preferences of Monroe residents and potential park users. These findings are integral to the recommendations of this master plan.

3.2 PUBLIC WORKSHOP

The City of Monroe conducted a public workshop (open house format) on November 6, 2017 at Monroe City Hall to introduce the project to the public and to solicit feedback from the community regarding the future of Baker Park. This meeting also invited attendees to provide input about Community Park, Monroe Bicentennial Commons, and the Great Miami River Trail.


3.2.1 Format

Upon arrival, attendees were asked to sign in and were then given a dot to place on a map to indicate where they live. This map (Figure 3.1) shows the distribution of the meeting attendees. The map indicates that the attendees were generally well-distributed throughout Monroe.



The meeting allowed participants to visit separate stations in order to provide their input on the three parks and to learn more about the planning process. At the Baker Park station, participants were asked, “What Would You Like to See at Baker Park?” A full list of comments can be found in Appendix A.

3.3 PUBLIC OPINION SURVEY


The following pages summarize the findings of the web and handout survey. The survey was completed by 493 individuals, about 60% of which were Monroe residents. The full results with all response options can be found in Appendix B.

3.3.1 Vision for Baker Park

Survey respondents previewed the concept plan from the Parks and Recreation Master Plan and were asked if the amenities proposed matched their vision for Baker Park. The results (Figure 3.2) indicate that most respondents (91%) indicated that the concept matched their vision for the park.

If the concept did not match their needs for Baker Park, respondents were invited to indicate what was missing. The following items were the most common responses (# of comments):


- Trails (5)
- Disc Golf (5)
- Pool (4)

Trails and disc golf were both included in the figure, so residents were likely reiterating their support for those features. The property is not suitable for a pool.

3.3.2 Most Important Features

Respondents were then asked to select the two features they would most like to see developed at the park. Figure 3.3 shows the results of this question. Of the options provided, nature trails and disc golf ranked first with 45% each, followed by a dog park at 30%. Disc golf was requested at all three parks (Community, Baker, and Bicentennial) in the survey and is recommended to be added at Baker Park. "Other" was selected by only 5% of respondents and skatepark (3) received the most comments.

3.4 STEERING COMMITTEE

Input was also gathered from a steering committee of community leaders and stakeholders at two meetings. The first meeting introduced the project, plus the Community Park and Monroe Bicentennial Commons Master Plans in progress concurrently, and included a visit to the Monroe Bicentennial Commons property to get an understanding of the current conditions of the site. The second meeting consisted of a presentation of a Preliminary Master Plan for Baker Park with examples of potential features.

At the end of the second meeting, the steering committee voted to support the concept presented in the Preliminary Master Plan and refer it to the Park Board and ultimately to City Council for approval. A summary of steering committee feedback can be found in Appendix A.

3.5 CONCLUSION

The public input reaffirms strong support for improvements indicated in the concept plan. Residents and visitors support the passive vision for the park with features such as nature trails, disc golf, and a dog park.



RECOMMENDATIONS

4.1 INTRODUCTION

This chapter presents the Master Plan for Baker Park, which shows the proposed features and arrangement at the park. The recommendations also include descriptions of the proposed features proposed and a cost estimate for development.

4.2 MASTER PLAN

The site Master Plan for Baker Park is presented in Figure 4.1. This map shows proposed features for the park as well as their locations and orientation. Feedback from the public engagement process was used to reaffirm the features indicated in the concept plan from the Parks and Recreation Master Plan. The concept plan was prepared in response to public input from that plan. The areas outlined in the Opportunities and Constraints map, presented in Chapter 2, were also used to determine the location and orientation of features. The proposed features at Baker Park are described in detail in the remainder of this chapter.

4.3 DOG PARK

A dog park was a feature requested during the Parks and Recreation Master Plan and was accordingly included in the concept plan for Baker Park. The public input during this master plan reaffirmed the need for a dog park. This feature was the third most important improvement in the web/handout survey (see Chapter 3) and was also requested at the public workshop.

Baker Park represents a logical location for the dog park because it has few immediate neighbors and is easily accessible from N. Main Street/Cincinnati-Dayton Road. None of the other parks in Monroe have the land needed for the development of a dog park. The Master Plan shows the dog park at the northern end of the park, the largest portion of the property located outside of the floodplain.

The dog park is divided into two large areas so that one can be opened at a time to allow for turf regeneration or to have separate areas for large and small dogs. Three areas may be needed if the dog park experiences heavy use. A gated entrance area is necessary to provide access to the main dog park areas to prevent off-leash dogs from escaping the dog park when visitors open a gate to one of the areas (see photo). Optimally, the dog park should also include a water fountain with a dog bowl and shaded areas for visitors.

4.4 TRAILS

Trails were the most needed facility in Monroe according to the Park and Recreation Master Plan, and nature trails were the most important feature to be included at Baker Park according to the web and handout survey (see Chapter 3). Because of this high level of support, a series of trails are recommended for Baker Park.

Most of the trails at the park are recommended to be natural surface trails, consistent with the natural and passive character of this park. Because much of the park is made up of open fields, most of these trails will consist of mowed paths through meadow areas (below left). A small portion of the trails will travel through the wooded area in the southeastern portion of the park (below right). The nature trails are separated into two loops (east and west) due to Miller Creek. Eventually a bridge should connect these loops and the two portions of the site. The east loop contains a paved gathering area that could also be used as a program space. A ½ mile paved trail loop is also recommended in the north portion of the park around the dog park.

4.5 NATURE RESTORATION

Because much of this park was cleared of vegetation for agricultural uses, restoration is needed throughout the site to provide a natural environment and desirable setting for the proposed nature trails. This restoration also provides educational opportunities through interpretive signage and programs. Approximately 20 acres of the property will be in need of restoration to a combination of meadow and woodland areas (see images under Section 4.4 Trails).

4.6 NATURE PLAYGROUND

In order to be a destination for families in Monroe, Baker Park should have play features for children. With the vision for Baker Park as a passive use natural area, a traditional steel and plastic playground would be out of place. A play area made from organic materials would be a better fit for the park and could provide an attraction that is different from what families can find at other nearby parks. The picture to the right shows a play structure in a natural setting with climbing features. This type of play structure would match the natural character of the park and offer a unique experience to visitors of Baker Park.

4.7 COMMUNITY GARDENS

According to the site analysis in Chapter 2, all of the land at Baker Park is prime farmland. The site was also formerly used as a farm, indicating good soils for crop production. Accordingly, community gardens at this park should utilize native soil rather than imported soil in raised garden beds. The image below shows a similar community garden in Bowling Green, Kentucky. The Master Plan shows a parking lot and a gathering shelter. The plots in the plan are 30'x30' with lines showing 15'x15' subdivision. The 20 large plots or 80 smaller plots represent a start as the area could easily support many more if demand requires. Fencing is recommended to keep deer and other animals out of the community garden area.



Minimal infrastructure is needed to begin offering community garden plots. Because the park has good soils, community gardens could likely be established by tilling the area and lining plots, although the soil should be tested before growing plants for consumption. The area would be accessed from N. Main Street/Cincinnati-Dayton Road and a parking area, which could start as a gravel lot. Water service also will be needed to provide a place near the gardens for users to fill watering containers.

Community gardeners are typically charged an annual fee to rent a plot (usually \$25 or less), and plot sizes vary. The City of Bowling Green, for example, charges \$20 for a 30'x60' plot and \$15 for a 30'x30' plot. Their gardens utilize native soil and the city simply plows, disks, and marks the plots each year. The city should advertise the gardens in advance to determine the level of demand and the number of plots needed.

4.8 DISC GOLF COURSE

Disc golf was indicated in the concept plan and was supported by the public input. The location of a potential disc golf course is undetermined, but it will need to avoid conflict with the other elements at the park, the dog park and nature trails in particular. The disc golf group indicated a willingness to provide labor for the development of additional disc golf courses in Monroe, so the city should seek dialogue with representatives of this group once the park is open to determine if sufficient support exists for the development of this facility at Baker Park.

4.9 OTHER FEATURES

A number of additional improvements are needed to accommodate the proposed facilities at Baker Park. An entrance road and parking lot is needed to provide access to the site. The site will also need utilities, including water and electric service. Entrance and wayfinding signage will need to be added as the park is developed and facilities are added. Picnic shelters and restrooms should be developed eventually to encourage extended stays and to accommodate events at the park.

4.10 COST ESTIMATE

A preliminary estimate of probable costs can be seen in Table 4.1. This estimate includes the costs for the improvements as outlined in this chapter. General costs and items not included in one of these areas are listed at the end of the table.

The Public Meeting was held on November 6, 2017 from 6:30 to 8:30 in the Monroe City Council Chambers. The meeting consisted of three primary stations: Baker Park, Community Park, and Monroe Bicentennial Commons Park/Great Miami River Trail, which each consisted of a series of presentation boards. Attendees were invited to share their ideas for improvements to the individual park at each of the stations. Keith Rodenhauser and Mark Horman provided a presentation of the Preliminary Master Plans for these three sites. We went through the opportunities and constraints of each of these sites and then provided a discussion in the Site Plans as well as some images of the facilities that would be developed within each of the parks. Some of the discussion items included the following:

1. Parts of the Belle of LeSourdsville River Boat are still at the site, but they are afraid to move anything because it could fall apart.
2. The naming rights to some of the sites is a possibility for fundraising.
3. At Route 73 and the Great Miami River, Metro Parks Butler County has a canoe/kayak launch site. This is about five miles upstream. The representative was concerned that it would be difficult for people coming from that location to get out where we show the canoe launch site, so they would have to paddle upstream in Gregory Creek. He suggested trying to put the launch on the main body of the river.
4. There was discussion that this type of a site would need staffing, such as Naturalists, a Park Overseer, Programming Staff, etc. Volunteers could provide some of these activities, but a dedicated staff should be involved, and this is to be discussed in the Master Plan.
5. A ½% income tax is in place and some of those funds are designated for Parks and Recreation and Monroe's Bicentennial Park.
6. A Metro Parks of Butler County representative indicated that there may be some confusion because there is a Bicentennial Commons Park in Middletown, which is five miles away.
7. It was also suggested that a Feasibility Study be prepared for potential methods of revenue generation. Some of the items potential methods include bike rentals, tournaments, an amphitheater, boat rentals, etc.
8. It was also suggested to possibly co-locate the playground and sprayground areas to one family friendly area.
9. The Steering Committee voted in favor of presenting this plan to the Parks Board and City Council for approval.


Following the meeting, it was noted that we need to schedule the Park Board Meeting and the City Council Meeting. It was eventually decided that Dan Arthur will provide an update to the Parks Board at their meeting next Tuesday, and we would present to Council on May 8, 2018. There will be an interim Park Board Meeting as well, on April 11, 2018, where we will need to present preliminary plans. When this is presented to the Council, it should be limited to about 15 minutes and also shortened for the Park Board as well. Information from this meeting will be provided to the City so they can send it in advance to the Parks Board and the City Council.


