EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 2018-11

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OR TRADE IN OF CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY NO LONGER NEEDED FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 721.15 authorizes the sale or trade in of personal property not needed for municipal purposes; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to authorize the sale or trade in of a 1996 John Deere 5300 Tractor and a 1997 John Deere 5400 Tractor each valued at one thousand dollars or more.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: Council hereby authorizes the sale or trade in of a 1996 John Deere 5300 VIN# LV5300D330645 and 1997 John Deere 5400 VIN# LV5400E543490, both of which are no longer needed for municipal purposes.

SECTION 2: This measure is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and further for the reason that Council desires to authorize the trade in at the earliest possible date to avoid delay in the purchase of new equipment for the Department of Public Works. Therefore, this measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after its adoption.
