EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 2018-13

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE TRADE IN OF CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY NO LONGER NEEDED FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 721.15 authorizes the trade in of personal property not needed for municipal purposes; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to authorize the trade in of two 2015 Ford Explorer police vehicles each valued at one thousand dollars or more.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: Council hereby authorizes the trade in of two 2015 Ford Explorer police vehicles, both of which are no longer needed for municipal purposes.

SECTION 2: This measure is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and further for the reason that Council desires to authorize the trade in at the earliest possible date to avoid delay in the purchase of new equipment for the Department of Police. Therefore, this measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after its adoption.
