

**ORDINANCE NO. 2018-08**

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING FACILITY DESIGN/OPERATIONAL EFFICIENCY ASSISTANCE AND BUILDING INFRASTRUCTURE FUNDS ASSOCIATED WITH THE PROPOSED RELOCATION OF CRANE CONSUMABLES.

WHEREAS, Crane Consumables has been located in Monroe since the start of the company in 2007 with three employees; and

WHEREAS, Crane Consumables has grown its operations to currently employ approximately 40 employees; and

WHEREAS, Crane Consumables is unable to continue to grow in its existing Monroe facility due to building size limitations and is therefore considering relocating to a larger building in Monroe or moving operations outside of Ohio; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to increase the competitiveness of the Monroe site under consideration.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:


SECTION 1: As an incentive to remain within the City of Monroe, Council authorizes facility design and operational efficiency services to Crane Consumables valued at \$15,000 and \$5,000 towards the cost of a concrete pad required for new heavy power infrastructure.

SECTION 2: The within described incentives shall be effective provided Crane Consumables maintains the payroll requirements commensurate with those thresholds required as part of any incentives from JobsOhio. Further, the incentives set forth herein shall expire six months from the effective date of this Ordinance and become immediately null and void should Crane Consumables move its proposed expansion and/or existing business outside of the City of Monroe.


SECTION 3: This measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
