

RESOLUTION NO. 08-2023

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT AND ENTER INTO A GRANT AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF MONROE AND THE OHIO ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY DIVISION OF DRINKING AND GROUND WATERS FOR AN EQUIPMENT GRANT TO PURCHASE AGREEMENT TO MONITOR THE PRESSURE IN THE CITY'S WATER SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, the west side of the City's water system does not have any water storage supporting this area of the system; and

WHEREAS, funds are available through the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, made possible by the H2Ohio initiative, for a grant for 100% of the cost of the purchase of equipment to help public water systems increase their technical capacity to provide a continuous source of safe drinking water; and

WHEREAS, the application must be filed by January 25, 2023, to meet the filing deadlines and the award of grant funds will be beneficial and necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, or welfare of the City as it directly relates to the quality of the City's drinking water; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency requires the governing body to authorize the application and use of the funding under this program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: The City Manager is hereby authorized to apply for and submit an Equipment Grant Application to the Ohio EPA Division of Drinking and Ground Waters for financial assistance for the purchase of two AFC Sepmer remote pressure monitoring sensors, and provide all information and documentation required in said Application for submission.

SECTION 2: This measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage pursuant to Section 7.08 (C) of the Charter.
