

**RESOLUTION NO. 35-2023**

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF MONROE AND THE OHIO PATROLMEN'S BENEVOLENT ASSOCIATION FOR THE PATROL OFFICERS..

WHEREAS, negotiations between the City of Monroe and the Ohio Patrolmen's Benevolent Association, have been ongoing; and

WHEREAS, as a result of said negotiations the parties have reached an agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a Collective Bargaining Agreement by and between the City of Monroe and the Ohio Patrolmen's Benevolent Association for the Patrol Officers, pursuant to the terms and conditions he deems appropriate and necessary in the best interest of the City.

SECTION 2: This measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage pursuant to Section 7.08 (C) of the Charter.
